Injured Fireman's Fund Guidelines

- 1. Preface:** The South County Professional Fire Fighters Association Injured Fireman's Fund was created to financially assist members with cost associated during an injury. The South County Professional Fire Fighters Association shall herein referred to as Local 4683, Union, SCPFFA, or association.
- 2. Eligibility:** The South County Professional Fire Fighters Association Injured Fireman's Fund is open only to those members of the Union and who are currently active and current with membership dues. A SCPFFA spouse can apply for the fund if the active member is unable to do so. The fund will be awarded without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, or state of physical handicap.
- 3. How to Enter:** To enter fill out a SCPFFA Injured Fireman's Fund Application and turn into the President or Vice President of the Union. The application should include the amount of funds requested and any supporting documents. (Example, copies of medical bills, paycheck stubs, etc). By submitting an application you authorize the committee to gather information to help render a decision.
- 4. Applicant review process:** An impartial committee made up of 5 members comprised of the President and Vice-President and 3 active members of the union will review all applications. The committee will vote using a ballot to decide whether or not to award the funds. The amount awarded will be determined by need and funds available in the Injured Fireman's Fund Account. In the event we receive insufficient information an administrative denial will be issued and will continue until we receive required documentation. The committee will render a decision within twenty (20) calendar days of receiving an application.
